D. Elwood Dunn PhD is the Alfred Walter Negley Professor of Political Science Emeritus, Seawanee, The University of the South. He earned his BA from Cuttington College & Divinity School; and his MA and PhD, from The American University. He has taught at Seton Hall University, Fordham University at Lincoln Center, Cuttington University, and the University of Liberia. He served in the government of his native Liberia (1974–1980), becoming Minister of State for Presidential Affairs (Chief of Staff, Office of the late President William R. Tolbert, Jr.). As a scholar, Dunn has authored, co-authored, and edited several books and articles. He was editor of the *Liberian Studies Journal* (1985–1995).

Dunn retired from academia in 2012. He now resides in Silver Spring, Maryland, USA
